



CDL Careers

As a CDL driver for local deliveries of wood trusses, you would be responsible for transporting these trusses from our manufacturing facility to construction sites. Some specific responsibilities may include:

1. Build truss package in yard with fork lifts, banding package and keeping load size as a non reducible.
2. Loading trusses onto your truck using a forklift or other equipment, and unloading trusses from trailer at construction site.
3. Inspecting the trusses for damage or defects before and after transport.
4. Securing the trusses with straps or other restraints to ensure they do not shift or fall during transport.
5. Following specific route to deliver trusses on time to the correct destination.
6. Communicating with customers and colleagues to coordinate delivery schedules and ensure customer satisfaction.
7. Maintaining accurate records of deliveries, including the number and type of trusses delivered, any damages, and the time of delivery.
8. Maintaining trucks, trailers and grease rollers.
9. Must be able to do heavy lifting.
10. Plow and shovel snow and remove snow piles when needed.

Typical work week is 35-50 hours per week depending on workload and desire to perform. General office hours are Monday thru Friday 8am to 5pm. Hours of operation vary due to seasonal changes in product demand.

Willingness to take on additional responsibilities is rewarded with additional compensation. Additional benefits include vacation pay, discounts, employer HSA contribution, health, vision, and dental insurance offered after 90 days.
