- Completion of the SBCA Truss Technician Level 1 curriculum or willingness to complete.
- Proficient use of PC systems required. Previous experience with Mitek Structure with integrated truss design in a production setting preferred.

Typical work week is 35-50 hours per week depending on workload and desire to perform. General office hours are Monday thru Friday 8am to 5pm. Hours of operation vary due to seasonal changes in product demand. Compensation is base hourly pay with additional commission pay based on sales. Experienced designers typically enjoy a yearly salary in the range of \$75,000 - \$130,000 based on sales and performance. Willingness to take on additional responsibilities is rewarded with additional compensation.
